



# The “Valleys Hundred” in Tredegar

The walk meets the half way point in Tredegar. To be able to walk a hundred miles you have to be good at map reading, You would not want to get lost and walk further than you need to!

In this work you will look at a map of Tredegar and decide what information the walker will need to know.



# National Curriculum Levels

## In this work you will:

- Locate places on a map using a four or six figure grid reference (**Level 5**)
- Use correct geographical vocabulary (**Level 6**)



# Learning Objective

- Understand OS map symbols, use four/six figure grid references and locate given places on the map

Walkers often want to find various places when they come down off the mountains and hit civilisation. All participants on the Hundred will have OS maps of the area. Help them find the nearest places when they reach the breakfast stop at Tredegar Comprehensive School. Give them a six figure grid reference for the following using the *Ordnance Survey Explorer Brecon Beacons National Park (East) Map - OS 13*

- Bus station
- Camping ground
- Pub
- Church with a tower
- Bunkhouse
- Leisure centre
- Public telephone
- Picnic site

- Now find your house on the OS map and give a six figure grid reference for its location

- Did you get them all right?
- Give your partner the grid reference for your house. Were they able to locate it on the map?
