


## The Dorset 100 28th to 30th May 2016

The Dorset 100 is a challenge event organised by the Dorset Group of the Long Distance Walkers Association (LDWA). The 100-mile anti-clockwise circular route, shown in outline above, passes through some of the finest inland countryside in Dorset, and visits places of historical and archaeological interest such as Moreton, Tolpuddle, Milton Abbas, Eggardon Hill, and the Kingston Russell Stone Circle. The area covered by the route is in the heart of Thomas Hardy's Wessex, and many of the places visited, such as Beaminster, Milton Abbas, and Evershot, are referenced in Thomas Hardy's novels.

The route includes sections of several long-distance trails including the Wessex Ridgeway, the Jubilee Trail, and the South Dorset Ridgeway, and goes over the highest points in Dorset, Lewesdon Hill and Pilsdon Pen.

The event starts and finishes at the Wey Valley School in Broadwey, close to Upwey station which is served by regular trains from Bristol and London.
