## THE GREENSAND RIDGE WALK - SUNDAY 10 JULY 2016

### THE WALK

40 miles **SOCIAL WALK** on the Greensand Ridge from Gamlingay to Leighton Buzzard (in a day). A provisional limit of 40 walkers, but if there is a large interest the number will be increased to a maximum of 49 (seat capacity of reserved coach).

### PARKING

All walkers to be at Baker Street Car Park, at junction with Church Street, Leighton Buzzard - GR SP 922 258 for a prompt 0600 departure by reserved coach to Gamlingay. **PLEASE CAR SHARE IF YOU CAN** The Baker Street Car Park is free for 24 hours on Sundays. If by any chance the car park is full there is parking in adjacent streets. If walkers wish to make their own way to Gamlingay they **MUST** indicate on the registration form and be at Gamlingay GR TL 227 532 no later than 06.50 am. There will be **NO** return transport to Gamlingay provided by BBN.

### START

The eastern end of the Greensand Ridge Walk in Gamlingay GR TL 227 532 at 0700

### DOGS

**SORRY - BUT NO DOGS ALLOWED**

### FINISH TIME

ETA at 23.00 on the Grand Union Canal towpath at the junction with the road bridge in Leighton Buzzard at GR SP 915 250. All walkers to finish at the same time. The walk from the finish to the car park is about 12 minutes, via West Street and Church Street.

### OBJECT

To provide a double length **social walk** for BBN members and other LDWA friends
