10 Discussion / Decision on Northern Triple Challenge

Tony had sent the outline of his Northern Triple Challenge proposals to HS who circulated it to all committee members, prior to the meeting and forwarded suggestions / comments to Tony for his response, basically over a three year period each event would run once (ie, tri-yearly). The committee's response raised the following points.

- For it to be regarded as a true triple event it should be held at a similar time each year. Tony's first event is planned in April, which would be difficult for East Lancs due to it clashing with the Two Crosses and the SWCP trip. Also, we could end up with the situation where there were six months between the first two events then eighteen months between the next two.
- It would be a great help if all groups were to share the resourcing for all the events which would also encourage the feeling of a true triple challenge.

Tony did send a well thought out and reasoned response, though the date of his event does seem fixed.

Following a discussion considering the various options, it was decided that although the group liked the idea in principle, we were not able to commit ourselves to the venture at this stage, **Action:** HS to inform Tony of our decision.
