Distance and Ascent taken from Google Earth.

Abbreviations (alphabetically): AH-Ahead, FB-Footbridge, FP- Footpath, JCT-Junction, KG-Kissing Gate, L- Turn Left, LMG-Large Metal Gate, LWG-Large wooden gate, R- Turn Right, SWG-Small wooden gate, TK-Track, WWW-Witton Weavers Way. X-Rds-Cross roads,

Hawkshaw to Jumbles 3.33 miles, Ascent 431ft Descent 587ft

- 9.1 From CP **CROSS ROAD WITH CARE**. Turn L to Village Store on R. Continue for 30yds to Two Brooks Lane. Turn R and keep R at the fork on track through trees for 0.3 mile. When the track starts to climb, look for a 'Village Link' way marker on the fence on the L. Turn R on path up hill over stile then L, then in 10yds fork R heading up hill to stile just after pond on R. Over and AH with remains of a hedge on L to stile, over and AH to reach road.
- 9.2 Turn R on road for 30yds, then **CROSS WITH CARE** to driveway to Tom Nook Farm. The FP is to the left of the driveway. Follow uphill to reach KG at Pack Horse Pub and road. Turn R for 70yds and cross **WITH CARE** to Roman Cross. Take path from the cross with pond on L, passing between hedge on L and fence on R to stile on R.
- 9.3 Over stile and AH following power lines downhill for 0.7 mile to tarmac road (**SD741 133**). L, downhill to reach A676 (**SD 738 132**). **CROSS WITH CARE** to tarmac lane opposite. AH to 2nd track on R through gate into woods and follow path 0.25 mile to T junction. Turn L down steps over FB and AH up steps to reach tarmac road. Turn R and AH 0.5 mile to reach sailing club on R and **FINISH**.
