Kent LDWA is ready for the White Cliffs Challenge on August 24, and we trust you are!

The route description has been checked on the marshals' walk, which was held last weekend, and it is now available to download – together with GPXs – from the website, at <https://www.ldwa.org.uk/Kent/W/6726/white-cliffs-challenge-2019.html>.

The event is based at St Margaret's Village Hall - grid reference TR 358336, postcode CT15 6AP. For getting there, take the A258 Dover-Deal Road from the Duke of York's roundabout just outside Dover. The turn-off for St Margaret's is the third turning on your right (opposite the turning for Martin Mill). Follow the road to the village, where you will see marshals who will direct you where to park. Please follow their instructions, and do not park on the concourse immediately outside the village hall, as this area is for marshals only. Registration is from 7.30am, with the start time for walkers 8.30am and 10.30am for runners.

There are four checkpoints for those of you on the 32-mile route; there are also two additional drinks stops. There is one checkpoint for the 18-milers (after about 9 miles) and a later drinks stop. And you will all get a hot meal at the end, provided by our catering team.

The emergency number is on the route description.

Enjoy the walk. We look forward to seeing you on Saturday week.
