SC thanked everyone for assistance – 122 paid entrants 108 starters – 103 finished Date to remain same weekend for 2014 re T de France but may amend in 2015

Email feedback requested -23 replies - summary positive on food - choice & preparation + ice cream, friendliness of che pre communication, halls & route generally + 40% of respondents will do it again Negatives: -

several would prefer an 8.30 start including Raynet – THIS TO BE ADOPTED IN 2014 but registration opening to rema 2013.

Route Description – wanted greater detail & correctness of Brimham Rocks CP – we are to refine route description but keep to 1 page although this should not be critical –

MORE SIGNAGE needed nr CP 1 + CP Brimham R + if we are to use same CPs then we need to ensure grid references Marshalls at Summerbridge Cross Roads said how dangerous it was to cross safely – we **ARE TO LOOK AT AMENDI** to finish (start is during a quiet period and can be kept) –, which would be less dangerous and free up 2x, marshals from a duty.

Additionally we are looking at cutting out the Lumley loop and expand the route from Brimham Rocks to remove walking.
