REPORT

A dry and at times sunny November day resulted in a pleasing entry for this local event and all but seven managed to complete their chosen route although the 4pm finishing limit arrived with over 30 still on route.

We had wondered if the semaphore tower, situated north of the bridleway over Ockham Common would prove difficult to find with so many paths around on the ground but this apparently did not prove difficult whilst checkpoint 6, the footpath junction with a concrete stile caused a number of groups to go astray. This checkpoint was included solely to prevent the uses of the carriage road which although looking inviting on the map was, as some of you will know, a boggy, overgrown track. However a number of walkers found it easily and a close reading of the directions - footpath junction and careful working out of the grid ref should have taken you all up the steps off the carriage road - ah well we tried!

We have tried with the present series of kanter to use less well-known areas away from the well trodden routes of the various Surrey challenge walks. This inevitably means that more problems are encountered along the route in the form of diversions, official or otherwise and hard to follow routes so we had to resort to giving a route description for the last 1½ miles. Some OS maps do not show the lakes you passed and those that do show the footpath going through the middle of one and then taking a different route through the wood to that on the ground. Thus the last section could have proved an interesting exercise relying on maps in the gathering gloom.

We anticipate organising another kanter for november 1985, possibly to the north of this years route around the Wisley and Pyrford area.
