Although most people kept to the official route at the end, there were still at least 3 alternative routes used in addition to the correct one. Still, next year should be interesting when people cut across the motorway (it opens in December!).

It is intended that next years event will take place on the same Sunday (the week before the Tanners Marathon) when (at last) there should be a BAe gala day of some sort. I also promise to amend the route description which has always been wrong in the Guildford area (how many noticed?).
