Last year, I wrote, "I don't think the weather could be worse next year" – I shouldn't tempt fate! There were some comments about mud and the difficult going between Dunsfold and Gibbett Hill. I can assure you I've walked this several times in better conditions and it's a beautiful route with fine views, especially of and from Gibbet Hill.

However, I do think the ground was drier than in 2001, including across Elstead common, although the sky was worse. I have had several comments back from walkers, thanking me for the challenge with 1 or 2 saying they hadn't believed a Surrey walk could be so difficult. Again, though, the marshals' walk was held with a blue sky all day and hard ground frozen for much of the way. 4 did the 25 mile walk - Ashley Saunders, John Lay, Molly Groundsell & Elaine Edwards in 8-58. (I did 21, as my grandchildren were visiting me). Jon Moore did 30 miles on a wetter day in 8-37.

198 entered the event (57 on the day), 19 failed to start and 19 did not finish either route, giving 160 finishers, 85 doing 30 miles and 75 doing 25 miles. As some check cards were rather soggy, there may be the odd mistake, tho I have checked both the Checkpoint records and the clipper marks.

Normally there is a small batch of runners starting at 10 am, but this year only Chris Fanning started then. He was the fastest finisher on the 30 course, running it in 5-11 whereas the last group of 3 took 10–48. On the 25 mile route, times ranged between K Saunders with 5-15 & Michael de Glanville in 10-33.

I would once again like to thank the marshals, who made it all work. Dave and Pat Challenger, Gillian Bull, Molly Groundsell, Derek Bowdell & Audrey Stein looked after Dunsfold; Louise & Tony Cartwright, John Lay, Elaine Edwards & Ray Jolly did Grayswood; Brian Haigh and Caroline & Ashley Saunders did Elstead – your guess on the number coming through was better than mine. Peter Bull was on his own on Gibbett Hill (only his vehicle could get there), as a checker and provider of 25 mile routes. Peter did extra service at the end, pulling cars off the verge where they were stuck. Before he arrived, I got exercise, pushing!

At Witley, Lesley Nightingale and Don Turner did the entries and logged in the finishers, putting in yet another very long day. And the marshals there benefited from the beautiful cooked breakfast Lesley gave us. Jon Moore also did entries, Peter Short worked outside and Jeff Ellingham & John Westcott also helped at the start. The kitchen was looked after by Derek Bowdell, Audrey Stein, Molly Groundsell, John Westcott, Peter & Elaine Edwards, Janet Chapman, John Lay & Jon Moore. Jeff Ellingham booked the hall and helped at the start and finish, including cleaning the showers at the end. Reg Chapman provided much of the equipment and closed the checkpoints. Gillian Bull was entry secretary and also helped at Dunsfold. Brian Haigh checked half of the route and Janet Chapman, Elaine Edwards & Molly Groundsell checked the other half. And after the event, Harry Wickens produced the usual detailed results. My grateful thanks to you all. My apologies to anyone I've missed.

I would also like to thank the committees for the Chichester hall at Witley, the sports pavilion at Dunsfold and the village halls at Grayswood and Elstead for the use of these and for their help.

And finally, can I thank everyone who took part. I hope you all enjoyed the event as much as I've enjoyed organising it (or at least most of it). This was the 8<sup>th</sup> time I organised this event & will be my last. I have enjoyed doing it – tho it is hard work – but I need a year off to revise my London Countryway book.

It will continue next year with John Lay & Peter Bull as joint organisers. Perhaps they will bring better weather and firmer ground!
