#### REPORT & RESULTS OF THE PUNCHBOWL MARATHON 20 & 30 MILE ROUTES - SUNDAY 7.2.82

What a difference 24 hours can make. On the saturday, I had enjoyed a lovely day, and with the route being the driest it has been for some time, had walked my best time. But the overnight rain changed the entire scene; then the steady drizzle & the muddy sections persuaded many to switch to the 20 mile route at Checkpoint One. Thus of the 393 entries, 170 completed the 30; 18 the 24; 119 the 20; & 4 the 27 mile route.

The rain caught out an amazing number who had nothing to cover their route description with. Even on a dry day a map case is a must, and in the wet two covers are best.

Being a marshall was, as usual, less enjoyable than walking; so I was very grateful for those who worked so hard from 8am to 6pm making sandwiches, standing in the rain for hours, then returning to supply endless beans on toast etc.

Mervyn Harvey & late starters checked you in at the start. Paul Houghton, Joyce & Carol Henley welcomed you to Checkpoint One. The 30 milers were later treated to hot coffee & sandwiches by Margaret Steer, Erica Blatchford & Richard Ireson. Leslie Nightingale & Bill Bleasedale checked you in at the Finish. Amongst other duties Arthur Radley held back the early eager males whilst the first six ladies took a shower. Mrs Bryon Alden was Chief Cook & bottlewasher until joined by Checkpoint Marshalls & early finishers; of whom David & Pauline Shore kindly kept me company whilst I waited for the last 4,ill-prepared 20 milers, to finish at 8.40pm.

It's usually the same people who get dragged out, or are persuaded not to walk, to help on Events. So could we please have some fresh offers of help for next year or even our Surrey Summits event on April 3/4th. Even offers to help with pre-organisation or the results would be gratefully received.

In the meantime there are plenty of other organised Events, almost every weekend, from 12 miles to 140 miles, all over the country. Each LDWA Group also organises it's own social walks & evenings, as well as open Events. And despite my note on the entry form, there IS a Sussex Group; & it's their Event that's next on the calender.
