## **Final Details**

Please note: Do ensure you bring a copy of the route description (downloadable from web). <u>There are no copies available at Registration</u>

- Dogs are the responsibility of the owner. Dogs must be under control at ALL times and carry 3<sup>rd</sup> party public liability insurance. We will need to see a copy of this insurance at Registration.
- The Walk HQ and start is at the Chichester Hall, Witley, GR SU948394. Chichester Hall is about 1 mile from Witley rail station. Anyone planning to use the train should check train times with the rail company on <a href="https://www.southwesttrains.co.uk">www.southwesttrains.co.uk</a>
- Please park on verge opposite NOT beside Hall, use minimum room to leave space for others There is addition parking at the railway station (free) a short distance away at SU948379.
- Starts are: 7.30-8.00am walkers, 8.30-9.00am runners and joggers. Latest start time 9.30am
- When you come into the Hall please do **NOT** wear muddy footwear or bring mud into the hall.
- We are using the LDWA's PACER event management system to oversee the event.
- On arrival at the Hall please collect your Entry Card from the registration desk. This card will be need to be given to timing marshals at each CP for recording. It will also be checked after the 20/30 route split. Don't bury it to deeply!
- You <u>must</u> check out with this card before starting otherwise your overall time may be in error
- When you return, check in on the verandah overlooking the field.
- Please respect the task of the timing marshals, friends, family and supporters can follow the event and selected participants online at <a href="https://www.ldwa.org.uk/results/">https://www.ldwa.org.uk/results/</a> Please ask your supporters to respect the task of the timing marshals and use the Public Results to follow your progress.
- If you wish to appear as 'anonymous' on the Public Results please indicate this at registration. Should you choose this option please remember that friends and family will be unable to identify and follow you on the Public Results.
- You should finish by 6pm at the latest. If you cannot finish, please drop out at a checkpoint if you can. You MUST let the organisers know if you drop out. Phone 07775 816004
- After finishing showers are available and there will be a hot meal. Badges will be on sale.
- Note that this is a winter event and conditions can be very rough, even in Surrey. They have been! There may be a number of wet and muddy paths. Make sure you have adequate waterproof clothing and sufficient warm clothes also have spare change for an emergency phone call. If you think you may finish after 5pm (because of your speed or losing your way) carry a torch!
- Don't forget your map(s): Landranger 186 (1:50 000) and/or Explorers 133 & 145 (1:25 000).

- Please return your card at the finish
