The new venue at Woodmansterne appeared to be well received, once the central heating moved into gear! There were 50 entries in all, and the clues were well interpreted apart from the railway milepost which foxed a few! The only major change was the landlord's name which was previously the clue for most inns no longer appearing above the front door. The area has done well to survive the current spate of pub closures, with the exception of The Victoria, Banstead. The intention was to be as close to a Keith Chesterton original as possible, with longer gaps between clues to avoid lots of stopping and to give more route choices. The Kanter was the first in the area since 1984. Most walkers and runners managed the route in good time. I am grateful to Mary Dumble for helping in the hall all day when a cold prevented her from taking part. For those that were wondering, Quality Street, one of the clues on the long route, was renamed after J.M. Barrie's play of the same name, in honour of two of the actors in the play who lived there at the time. The chocolate box was also named after the play. The long route visited Gatton Park, another outpost of Capability Brown, and the clue was based on a present day stone circle.
