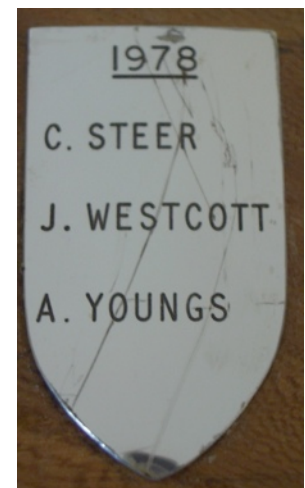
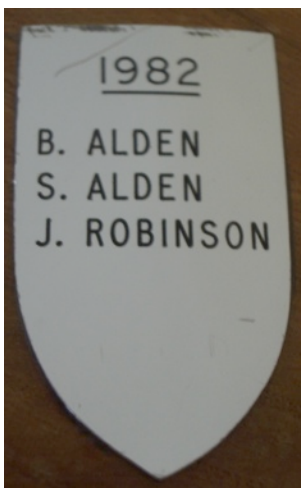


The Gibbet Trophy



Awarded to the fastest team from within the Surrey Group. Its sister trophy, the Leith Trophy, was awarded to the fastest non-Surrey team. A team consisted of at least 3 walkers who had to walk the entire route as a group. In 1978 it was awarded to Chris Steer, John Westcott, & Tony Youngs; in 1980, Robin Paul, Tony Youngs & Chris Steer and in 1982, to the father and son Brian & Steve Alden & John Robinson.



The Summits was a purely walking event and the trophies were withdrawn after 1982 to discourage running.
