Report and Results of the Twentieth Winter Tanners

12th January 1997

Two days previously Surrey was still in the grip of an arctic winter; 48 hours earlier there had been warnings of black ice and exhortations to motorists to stay at home. But on the day the snow had all gone, there was no rain and we even had a few minutes of blue skies and watery sunshine. Once again the marshals did a super job; Dave Challenger and Dave Green at the Start and also at CP 1 supplemented by Pat Challenger and Ken Styan. At CP2 we had Sue Boyman, Cyril Watmore, my daughter Julia and Dave Green again. Dave also helped out at the finish. The YH at Tanners Hatch again provided refreshments thanks to the Warden, Graham Peddie. Thanks also to John Westcott for producing the route description.

As is usual for this event the route was different to the previous year. Instead of heading off into the Surrey hills it made its way to Epsom, crossing the race course before reaching CP1 in Horton Country Park. After that it visited part of residential Surrey, skirting Claygate to reach CP 2 at Browns Corner near Cobham where one eagle eyed entrant spotted snooker professional Jimmy White out walking with some of his children. Next to come into view was Polesden Lacey, owned by the National Trust which will benefit to the time of £102.50 from the generous donations provided by the entrants. Tanners Hatch YH was soon reached and some began to have suspicions that there could be some mud before the finish. And they were right! The normal route from the YH to the finish had to be extended a little, an opportunity not to be missed to fit in some deep mud on a narrow path which could not be bypassed.

In general times were a little faster than last year no doubt helped by the lack of hills. Hilary Walker belied her name by finishing first in the impressive time of 4.26. The number of entries were about the same; five retired resolving they would complete it next time and two failed to report in at the finish. Once again the popularity of this no frills event was demonstrated by the support received. Many thanks to all for taking part.
